**If You Were Charged an Inactivity Fee on Your MGM Gift Card, You May be Entitled to a Payment from a Class Action Settlement.**

**Claim ID: 30988A1B2C3D4**

This Notice is to inform you that a settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit claiming that Defendants MGM Resorts International and Costco Wholesale Corporation charged customers monthly inactivity fees in violation of the federal Electronic Funds Transfer Act and other state laws (the "Settlement"). MGM and Costco deny they violated any law, but have agreed to the Settlement to avoid the uncertainties and expenses associated with continuing the case.

**Am I a Class Member?** Our records indicate you may be a Class Member. Class Members are United States residents who from October 24, 2010 to July 31, 2018 were charged inactivity fees on their MGM Gift Cards.

**What Can I Get?** If the Settlement is approved by the Court, MGM and Costco will establish a Settlement Fund of \$150,000 to pay all valid claims submitted by the Class, together with notice and administration expenses, attorneys' fees and costs, and an incentive award. If you are entitled to relief, you may submit a Claim Form to receive a *pro rata* (meaning equal) share of the Settlement Fund.

**How Do I Get a Payment?** You must submit a timely and complete Claim Form **no later than October 29, 2018**. You can file a claim by clicking the "Submit Claim" button on the Settlement Website, [www.giftcardclassactions.com](http://www.giftcardclassactions.com). Payment will be distributed to you via check from the Settlement Administrator.

**What are My Other Options?** You may exclude yourself from the Class by sending a letter to the Settlement Administrator no later than **October 15, 2018**. If you exclude yourself, you cannot get a Settlement payment, but you keep any rights you may have to sue MGM and Costco over the legal issues in the lawsuit. You and/or your lawyer have the right to appear before the Court and/or object to the proposed Settlement. Your written objection must be filed no later than **October 15, 2018**. Specific instructions about how to object to, or exclude yourself from, the Settlement are available at [www.giftcardclassaction.com](http://www.giftcardclassaction.com). If you file a claim or do nothing, and the Court approves the Settlement, you will be bound by all of the Court's orders and judgments. In addition, your claims against MGM and Costco relating to the alleged inactivity fees will be released.

**Who Represents Me?** The Court has appointed lawyers Rafey S. Balabanian and Eve-Lynn Rapp of Edelson PC to represent the Class. These attorneys are called Class Counsel. You will not be charged for these lawyers. If you want to be represented by your own lawyer in this case, you may hire one at your expense.

**When Will the Court Consider the Proposed Settlement?** The Court will hold the Final Approval Hearing at 1:30 p.m. PST on November 9, 2018 in Courtroom 13106, United States District Court, 700 Stewart Street, Seattle, Washington. At that hearing, the Court will: hear any objections concerning the fairness of the Settlement; determine the fairness of the Settlement; decide whether to approve Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and costs; and decide whether to award the class representative an award from the Settlement Fund for their service in helping to bring and settle this case. MGM and Costco have agreed to pay Class Counsel reasonable attorneys' fees in an amount to be determined by the Court. Class Counsel will seek no more than 33 1/3% of the Settlement Fund, but the Court may award less than this amount. Class Counsel will file their motion for attorney's fees no later than **October 1, 2018**, and a copy of the motion will be available at [www.giftcardclassaction.com](http://www.giftcardclassaction.com).
